

# ARIAS System Training

ARIAS is the platform that OHA, Counties, and potentially some Tribes in Oregon will use to record data from COVID-19 contact tracing calls.

This predominantly self-guided, virtual training is meant to familiarize you with using ARIAS in a practice/test environment with mock contacts. This training is estimated to take 3-4 hours to complete and consists of three parts: video instruction, practice and a live Q&A session.

## For this training you will need:

### Materials:

- ARIAS User Guide (pdf)
- ARIAS FAQ (pdf)
- Contact Tracing Script  
*\*OHA's script is provided with training materials, but if available, use the script provided to you by the County or Tribe you are working with*

**Pre-requisites (recommended):** Required trainings will differ depending on the County or Tribe you are working on behalf of. Here are some examples:

### Technology:

- **ARIAS Access:** ARIAS is a web-based platform. The recommended browsers are Firefox and Chrome. Some versions of Explorer and Safari do not fully support ARIAS.

- **ZOOM:** The ZOOM video conferencing platform has been chosen for the live Question & Answer Session. ## Training Instructions:

### Step 1: Contact Tracing Data Collection: ARIAS Training (video)

This 41-minute video provides a basic overview of the ARIAS system for contact tracers. It can be viewed and revisited as needed. The ARIAS User Guide document (pdf) is a companion to the video in addition to being quick reference that you can use after training.

## Step 2: ARIAS “Sandbox” Practice Tasks:

Login to the test environment or “Sandbox” site for the ARIAS contact tracing database using your personal Microsoft Sign-In ID (i.e.: *your.name@dhsaha.state.or.us*) provided by ARIAS Support “Login Instruction” email.

Based on what you learned in the video, please practice the following tasks:

- Change your time zone to Pacific Time.**
- Create a new assessment for one of your contacts.**
- Pretend dialogue: go through the script and update a contact and assessment.**  
*(If possible, use a colleague, friend or family member to “play” the contact - using their answers in real time to enter data into ARIAS.)*
- Reassign one of your contacts to user named Shaun Parkman.**
- Pin the “My active contacts with symptoms” to the “Pinned” section.**
- Pin one assessment to your “Pinned” section.**
- Deactivate one contact, use the “All contacts” system view and the search box to find the contact again. Reactivate the contact record again and assign to yourself.**

## Step 3: Live Orientation/Q&A Session

A one-hour, live orientation via ZOOM for new ARIAS users. This orientation will provide an open forum to ask questions, get additional instruction or demonstration, explore best practices, and get tips from an ARIAS trainer or other users.
