Based on input from DOE and stakeholders during the review process, additional changes were made to the final USDOE State Plan Appendix D Health & Safety. Memo WX-2024-2 is being rereleased to reflect these. Changes made after the draft state plan was released are in <u>italics</u> to assist in identifying additional updates.

V. 2 pg.74 For homes with Category 1 combustion appliances, depressurization and spillage tests must be done before leaving the home on any day when work has been done that could affect draft (i.e., — air sealing or duct sealing or adding exhaust ventilation. As a reminder, the American Gas Association (AGA) classifies a category 1 appliance as non-condensing, negative-pressure venting with an estimated efficiency of 83% or less and typically utilizes standard b-vent or masonry venting.

CO Alarms: In all home where these devices are nonexistent or inoperable, weatherization agencies must install CO alarms within 15 feet of the sleeping rooms. (OAR 837-047-0130)

Removed: Confirmation of Receipt of Mold and Moisture Pamphlet (Required if any inspection items are marked "yes") on Sample Dwelling Inspection. Confirmation is required either way.

Pg. 115 XII. COVID-19 and Infectious Diseases: Workgroup agreed to leave as a placeholder in the event this section may be needed again leaving a few generalized sentences.
