Contested Cases, Retail Appointments Heard by Commissioners

Groundbreaking for New Warehouse Scheduled

PORTLAND, Ore. – At its regularly scheduled meeting today, Commissioners acted on stipulated settlements, made retail appointments and heard a staff presentation.

A ceremonial groundbreaking at the future site of the agency's new warehouse in Canby has been set for December 5. Additionally, in the presentation made to commissioners today, it was discussed that work is near complete on pricing for the project, and an example was shown of the computer modeling being done to ensure appropriate sizing of building systems. Workshops will take place to get further detail for construction.

Commissioners approved two appointments for liquor store agents. Gregory Crain was appointed the agent for the Arlington store, as the result of the former agent's retirement. Bridgeport Beverage Co., (Eric Larson) was appointed the agent for the liquor store in Hood River.

The Commission also ratified three stipulated settlement agreements for alcohol licensees and a marijuana permittee. Detailed information on the specific cases below can be found on the OLCC website:

Alcohol Stipulated Settlement Agreements

TRAIL DISTILLING (DIST) in Oregon City, will pay a \$2,475 fine, **AND** serve a six-day suspension for one violation.

STEVE'S BKFST & MORE (F-COM) in Springfield, will pay either a \$5,280 fine, OR serve a thirty-two-day suspension for three violations if age verification equipment is installed and in use by Oct 1, 2024; or licensee will pay either a \$7,780 fine, OR serve a forty-two-day suspension for three violations if age verification equipment is not installed and in use by Oct 1, 2024.

Marijuana Stipulated Settlement Agreements

ASHIA ROSS (Permittee) in Salem <u>will pay a \$525 fine</u>,OR <u>serve a twenty one-day permit suspension</u> for one violation.
