2024 Cannabis Bill & Technical Rules Advisory Committee

Agenda

The Oregon Legislature passed House Bill 4121 during the 2024 Oregon legislative session which has several provisions that require agency rulemaking to implement. Further, the agency must also undertake rulemaking to respond to changes within the industry. The topics which require OLCC rulemaking are:

- Presumptive marijuana testing methodology (related to ODA regulation of hemp growers)
- Standards for artificially derived cannabinoids in the general market
- Hemp product registration and labeling requirements
- Marijuana license caps and moratorium
- Hemp minor decoy operations
- Temporary worker permits

In order to address these issues, and respond to other issues within the regulated marketplace, staff plans to hold several focused advisory committee meetings with industry and public health partners to develop rules. This work may require Commission staff to separate this rules package into smaller rule actions. Staff will update Commissioners as the rulemaking proceeds throughout 2024.
