DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

IEIM Section Chief

Responsible to the Propulsion Flight Chief for the leadership, supervision, and training of assigned personnel. Provide direction to resolve problems on aircraft engines in a field level environment. Assigns tasks to be performed within JEIM. Explains work requirements, methods, and procedures to assigned personnel. Instructs subordinates on new procedures or methods and provides assistance on difficult or new problem areas. Plan and monitor the progress of JEIM production, ensuring maintenance schedules are met by anticipating material required and managing delays to prevent schedule disruptions to support operational requirements and maintain required WRE levels. Makes adjustments as necessary to effectively and economically accomplish the work. Ensures members are following proper maintenance, documentation, and safety practices by performing supervisor inspections. Assures that equipment and material is available when needed. Maintains production reports and records.
