## **Change Advisory: Division 41 NPA Update**

## **Summary**

Division 41 of the practice act was updated 12/01/24. The Board approved the proposed changes during the 11/21/24 Board meeting. The nurse intern license is under-utilized in the State of Oregon due to known barriers surrounding initial licensure and renewal of licensure. These rules attempt to remove barriers to obtaining an initial NI license by allowing students more opportunities to complete the application requirements and at an earlier point in their nursing education. The license has been extended to allow students additional opportunities to work as nurse interns. With the license extension, we have clarified that licensees have a duty to report changes related to their student-status.

## **Impact**

**Internal:** The nurse intern license has a zero (\$0) fee application. Extending the license will reduce OSBN staff processes surrounding renewals.

**External:** Individuals with an extended license will have greater opportunity to earn income in nurse intern roles.
