Reimbursement Rate Scale for Volunteer IMT Members

OBJECTIVE: Create equitable pay scale for volunteer IMT members

I. SCOPE

This SOG outlines the reimbursement rates for IMT members who identify as volunteers.

II <u>GUIDELINES</u>

The reimbursement process itself will continue to follow the guidelines provided in the current Oregon Fire Service Mobilization Plan, which no longer identifies a rate for overhead team members.

Many agencies will add roll-ups to the rates outlined below. Those costs may include – but are not limited to – workers' compensation insurance, transit taxes, PERS payments, etc.

III. METHODOLOGY

The rates below are based off of the current USFS AD Pay Plan for Emergency Workers. Because the presumption is that a USFS AD employee is being paid for no more than 16 hours per day, the following formula was used to determine the appropriate reimbursement rate for OSFM volunteer team members:

U * 16 / 24

where U is the USFS AD rate for the position

IV. MAINTENANCE

OSFM will revise this SOG prior to fire season; only when USFS has updated their AD pay plan.

V. RATES

The rates below become effective April 1, 2021. The previous rate schedules are included in the attachments of this guideline.
