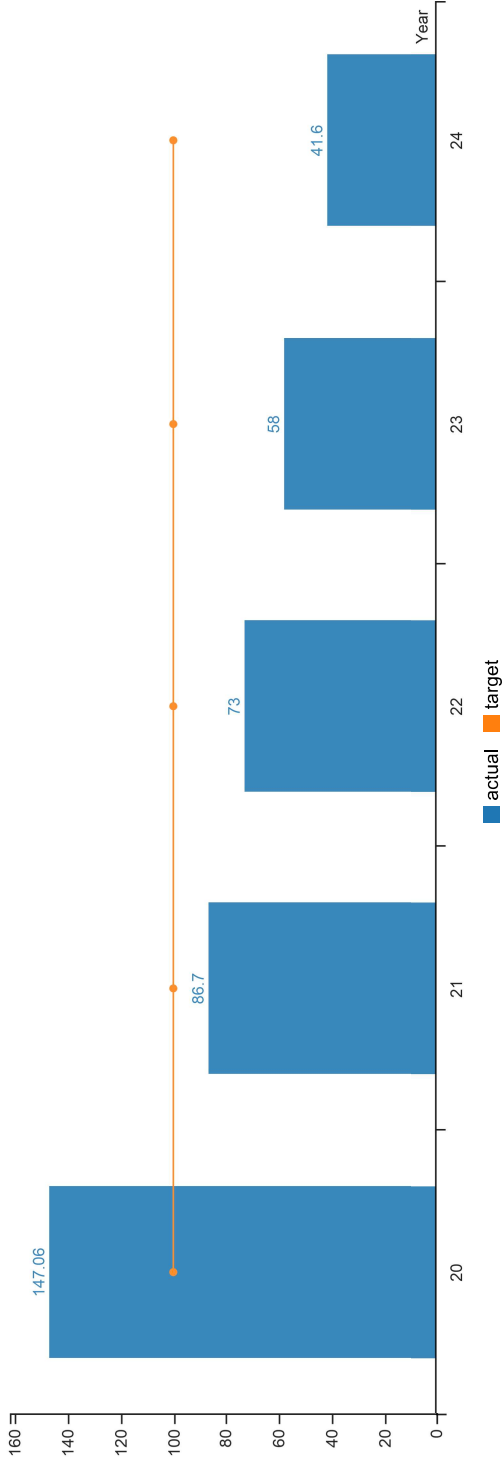

The Oregon Racing Commission saw an increase in fatalities in fiscal year 2024. The number per 1000 was 3.6 on a goal of 1.5. Five horses were euthenized due to racing injuries that were catastrophic.
