RULE TITLE: Boat Operations in Marion County

NOTICE FILED DATE: 11/09/2018

RULE SUMMARY: The amendment to OAR 250-020-0259 Boat Operations in Marion County adds a restriction on Turner Lake prohibiting a person from propelling a boat with a motor, except an electric motor, and limiting the speed of boats propelled by electric motors to 5 MPH. Turner Lake is located east of Turner Rd SE and south of Ahrens Rd SE. Edits are also conducted to remove obsolete language and alphabetize the waterbodies.

RULE TEXT:

- (1) Elk Lake: A person must not use a motor, except an electric motor, to propel a boat.
- (2) Goose Lake: A person must not use a motor, except an electric motor, to propel a boat.
- (3) Mission Lake: A person must not use a motor, except an electric motor, to propel a boat.
- (4) Silverton Reservoir: A person must not use a motor, except an electric motor, to propel a boat.
- (5) Turner Lake:
 - (a) A person must not use a motor, except an electric motor, to propel a boat.
 - (b) A person must not operate a boat propelled by an electric motor in excess of 5 MPH.
- (6) Walter Wirth Lake: A person must not use a motor, except an electric motor, to propel a boat.
