
Demonstrating Content Knowledge through Multiple Measures Completion Reporting Process



(1) The MM Testing Equivalency form must also be submitted for pre-service candidates demonstrating language proficiency through MM options for the Dual Language Specialization to document method met.

Demonstrating Content Knowledge through Multiple Measures Completion Reporting Process

Pre-Service Candidates Completing Initial Licensure Programs

- 1. Using the Oregon Multiple Measures <u>Content Knowledge</u> or <u>Dual Language Proficiency</u> Guidance for Pre-Service Candidates as applicable, the EPP determines the option through which the candidate meets the requirement for each endorsement pursued or the Dual Language specialization.
- 2. When the candidate completes all program requirements, the EPP submits the PCR(s) for Preliminary Teachers and indicates the content mastery demonstration method used.

a. One endorsement only:

Submit one PCR and indicate the content mastery demonstration method used (either through subject matter exam or based on a multiple measures assessment).

 Multiple endorsements - <u>same</u> content mastery demonstration method for <u>all</u> endorsements: Submit one PCR and select the content mastery demonstration method used (either all through subject matter exam or all based on multiple measures assessments).

Example:

A candidate completed an initial licensure program with endorsements in Advanced Math and Integrated Science. Content mastery has been demonstrated through a multiple measures option for both endorsements.

The EPP submits one PCRs listing both endorsements and indicating multiple measures options were used.

c. *Multiple endorsements - <u>different</u> content mastery demonstration method for <u>each</u> endorsement: Submit a separate PCR for each endorsement to document the method used (either through subject matter exam or on the basis of a multiple measures assessment).*

Example:

A candidate completed an initial licensure program with endorsements in Elementary – Multiple Subjects and ESOL. Content mastery for Elementary – Multiple Subjects has been demonstrated through a multiple measures option and for ESOL through a passing content exam.

The EPP submits two PCRs: one for Elementary – Multiple Subjects indicating a multiple measures option was used and another one for ESOL indicating completion of the subject matter exam in this area.

In-Service Candidates Completing Program-Required Added Endorsements

- 1. Using the Oregon Multiple Measures <u>Content Knowledge</u> or <u>Dual Language Proficiency</u> Guidance for Pre-Service Candidates as applicable, the EPP determines the option through which the candidate meets the requirement for each endorsement pursued or the Dual Language specialization.
- When the candidate completes all program requirements, the EPP submits the PCR(s) for Added Endorsements and indicates content mastery was demonstrated through subject matter exam for all endorsements listed* AND emails a completed Multiple Measures (MM) Testing Equivalency Form to <u>richelle.krotts@tspc.oregon.gov</u> within 24 hours of PCR entry.

*Note: Demonstration through subject matter exams is currently the only available selection on the PCR for added endorsements

3. Once received, the MM Testing Equivalency Form will be added to the candidate's eLicensing account for evaluator review.
