11	Certified Mail Receipt 7018 1830 0001 6178 6445 to the address on file with the Commission. The
12	Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The
13	Certified Mail receipt was returned signed, to the Commission on September 14, 2019. The regular,
14	first class mail was not returned to the Commission, and assumed to have been delivered. The Notice
15	of Opportunity of Hearing, dated September 4, 2019, and signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive
16	Director, stated:

30	FINDINGS OF FACT
31	 Stephen Diehl has been licensed by the Commission since July 19, 2011. Diehl held a Charte
32	School Registry, with an endorsement in Administrator (PP-12), valid from October 7, 2016
33	through October 7, 2019. Diehl has not made application for renewal of his license. During a
34	relevant times, Diehl was employed by the Luckiamute Valley Charter School (LVCS) as an
35	administrator (Principal).
36	
37	2. On December 22, 2017, the Commission received a report from the Oregon Department of
38	Human Services (DHS) indicating Diehl, on December 13, 2017, had engaged in unwanted,
39	offensive physical contact with student RT. On December 29, 2017, the Commission receive
40	a misconduct report from the Dallas School District regarding the same incident.

The Commission hereby suspends Steven M. Diehl's Oregon educator license for a period of ninety (90) days, to begin upon the date this order is signed and in effect.

3	following terms and conditions:

8	Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for
9	the Commission to revoke Diehl's teaching license or otherwise impose discipline, after
10	first providing Diehl with notice and opportunity for hearing.
