10	On March 28, 2019, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
11	(Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Isaiah White (White) in
12	which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty and Gross Unfitness.
13	The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7018 1830
14	0001 6178 3529 to the address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the
15	Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified
16	Mail was returned to the Commission "Unclaimed". The regular first class mail was not
17	returned to the Commission, and assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of
18	Hearing, dated March 28, 2019, and signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director,
19	stated:
20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28	"IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING OR IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH WILL REVOKE YOUR OREGON TEACHING LICENSE AND REVOKE YOUR RIGHT TO APPLY FOR A TEACHING LICENSE."
29	White did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds White to be in
30	default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order,
31	based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
32	
33	FINDINGS OF FACT
34	1. Isaiah White has been licensed by the Commission since December 7, 2015. White's
35	Initial Teaching License, with an endorsement in World Language: Russian (PK-12),
36	was valid from December 7, 2015 through June 2, 2017. During all relevant times,
37	White was employed by the North Marion School District (NMSD).

On March 16, 2017, the Commission received a report from the Clackamas County
 Sheriff's Office containing information that White, while employed as a substitute
 teacher with the NMSD, was under criminal investigation for possession of child
 pornography on White's personal computer, including digital images and videos of a
 minor aged female family member taken clandestinely. White was arrested and
 charged with six felony sex crimes.

9 3. On September 26, 2018, White plead guilty to, and was convicted of, two counts of
ORS 163.686, Encouraging Child Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree, a Class C
Felony, and two counts of ORS 163.701, Invasion of Personal Privacy in the First
Degree, a Class C Felony. White was sentenced to 36 months supervised felony
probation, including the requirement that White register as a sex offender.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

16 Isaiah White' criminal convictions as described in section three (3) above, constitute gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-17 0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment); and 18 OAR 584-020-0040(1) (The Commission will deny, revoke or deny the right to apply 19 20 for a license or charter school registration to any applicant or educator who, has been 21 convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143, or the substantial equivalent of 22 any of those crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction, or convicted of attempt to 23 commit such crimes as defined in ORS 161.405), including ORS 163.686 -24 Encouraging Child Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree, and ORS 163.701 – Invasion of 25 Personal Privacy in the First Degree. This conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in 26 violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) (Conviction of violating any 27 federal, state, or local law. A conviction includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty plea, no contest plea or any other means); OAR 28 29 584-020-0040(5)(d) (Commission of an act listed in OAR 584-020-0040(1); and OAR 30 584-020-0040(5)(e) (Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, 31 even in the absence of a conviction).

2	Pursuant to ORS 342.175(3) and OAR 584-020-0040(1) the Teacher Standards
3	and Practices Commission must revoke White's license and / or his right to apply for a
4	license based on the conviction of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143(3)(a), or the
5	substantial equivalent of any of those crimes, or convicted of attempt to commit such
6	crimes as defined in ORS 161.405.
7	
8	Furthermore, the conduct underlying White's convictions as described in section
9	two (2) above, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR
10	584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional
11	judgment); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f) (Any sexual conduct with a student) as defined by
12	OAR 584-020-0005(5); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-
13	0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and
14	conversations at all times); and OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a)(Maintain the dignity of the
15	profession by respecting and obeying the law, exemplifying personal integrity and
16	honesty). Additionally, White's criminal convictions and conduct related to his
17	convictions constitute "gross unfitness" in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-
18	020-0040(3)(c) and (d) as defined by OAR 584-020-0040 (5) (Gross unfitness is any
19	conduct which renders an educator unqualified to perform his or her professional
20	responsibilities).
21	
22	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
23	ORS 342.175.
24	FINAL ORDER
25	The Commission hereby revokes Isaiah White's Oregon educator license and his
26	right to apply for an Oregon educator license.
