14 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

15 The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS  
16 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use*  
17 *professional judgment*), and OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a) (*Maintain the dignity of the*  
18 *profession by respecting and obeying the law, exemplifying personal integrity and*  
19 *honesty*). The above conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS  
20 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(b) (*Fraud or misrepresentation*); and 584-020-  
21 0040(5)(c) (*Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction*  
22 *includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty*  
23 *plea, no contest plea or any other means*).

25 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon  
26 ORS 342.175.


