






**STIPULATION OF FACTS**

1. The Commission has licensed Genthner since March 18, 2005. Genthner currently hold a Preliminary Teaching License, with endorsements in English Language Arts (PK-12), Legacy Middle Level (PK-12), and Special Education: Generalist (PK-12) valid from September 4, 2019 through December 26, 2022. During all relevant times, Genthner was employed by South Lane School District (SLSLSD).
2. On May 9, 2019, the Commission learned that Genthner had been working as a teacher for the SLSLSD since the expiration of her previous license on December 26, 2017.
3. Investigation determined Genthner had been providing teaching services for a period of approximately twenty (20) months to the SLSLSD. The gap in Genthner’s licensure was due in part to the district failing to notify Genthner of her upcoming renewal, as had been a long-standing district practice; Genthner failing to notice reminders from TSPC of her need to renew her license; and Genthner’s errant understanding of the Commission’s online application process.

**CONCLUSION OF LAW**

The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (*Working without a license*); and OAR 584-050-0035 (1) (*Any person employed in a position in a school district, education service district, or charter school for which a license or registration is required pursuant to ORS Chapter 342, must hold a valid license or registration appropriate for the assignment while working as a public school, education service district or charter school employee*).

1           The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon  
2   ORS 342.175.
