


15 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

16 Peter N. Harley's conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in
17 violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-
18 020-0010(1) (*Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each*
19 *individual*), OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-
20 0025(2)(e) (*Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations*); OAR 584-020-
21 0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(b) (*Refrain from exploiting*
22 *professional relationships with any student for personal gain, or in support of persons*
23 *or issues*), OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(A) (*Not demonstrating or expressing*
24 *professionally inappropriate interest in a student's personal life*), and OAR 584-020-
25 0035(1)(c)(D) (*Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and*
26 *conversations at all times*).

27 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
28 ORS 342.175.

30 **ORDER**

31 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
32 conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Peter N. Harley's
33 Oregon educator license.


34 Furthermore, the Commission imposes a period of two (2) years of probation
35 upon Harley's licensure to commence from the date this order is signed by the
36 Commission and subject to the following condition:

1. Harley shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division 020.
2. Harley shall successfully complete Commission approved training courses on classroom management and teacher/student boundaries within 60 days of the adoption of this final order and provide evidence to the Commission of such training.
