1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 Educator License of FINAL ORDER OF PUBLIC 5 MICHAEL J. WHALEN) REPRIMAND AND PROBATION 6 7 On September 24, 2020, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 8 (Commission) received a misconduct report from the Klamath County School District 9 indicating possible professional misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Michael J. 10 Whalen (Whalen). 11 After review of the matters alleged, Whalen and the Commission agree that their 12 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 13 certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand and a three (3) year period of 14 probation. 15 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 16 sanction to be imposed. In entering into this stipulation, Whalen waives the right to a 17 hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 18 By signing below, Whalen acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 19 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest 20 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 21 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 22 Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); 23 (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public 24 upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent 25 upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does 26 not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Whalen nor the 27 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and 28 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or 29 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of 30 the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has 31 been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 32 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 33 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an 34 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of

the Stipulated Final Order below.

1		STIPULATION OF FACTS
2	1,	The Commission has licensed Whalen since August 7, 1998. Whalen currently
3		holds a Professional Teaching License, with an endorsement in Advanced
4		Mathematics (PK-12), valid from December 16, 2019, through January 19, 2025.
5		During all relevant times Whalen was employed by the Klamath County School
6		District.
7	2.	On September 24, 2020, the Commission received a report from the Klamath
8		County School District (KCSD) indicating Whalen had engaged in conduct that
9		may be considered gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. Specifically the
10		report alleged Whalen misused school district computer equipment and his
11		school district email account during work hours to communicate non-school
12		related business, some of which was provocative in nature, to persons not
13		associated with the district
14	3.	Investigation determined that on September 3, 2020, the district began
15		investigating Whalen after receiving a screenshot showing an inappropriate
16		message allegedly sent from Whalen to a colleague during an online Zoom
17		meeting. Whalen said he was previously sent the message by a colleague and then
18		forwarded the message, which was intended to be a joke, to another colleague.
19		Whalen apologized to the colleague that day. Further district investigation found
20		that since 2011, there were numerous non-school related emails sent by Whalen
21		during work hours, some of which were sent during scheduled teaching time. In
22		Whalen's KCSD and TSPC interviews, Whalen admitted to using district
23		resources to send non-school, non-student related emails, some of which were
24		inappropriate for district email, on numerous occasions. The KCSD suspended
25		Whalen for two (2) days and gave him a letter of reprimand.

1	CONCLUSION OF LAW
2	The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS
3	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use
4	professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(b) (Using and maintaining district
5	property, equipment, and materials appropriately), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using
6	district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b) (Skill
7	in communicating with administrators, students, staff parents, and other patrons);
8	OAR 584-020-0040(4)(a) (Substantial unauthorized use of: school name or financial
9	credit school materials and equipment for personal business; or school personnel to
10	provide personal services unrelated to school business); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(b)
11	(Substantial unauthorized use of employment time or school resources for private
12	purposes).
13	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
14	ORS 342.175.
15	
16	ORDER
17	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
18	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Michael J.
19	Whalen's Oregon educator license.
20	Furthermore, the Commission imposes a period of three (3) years of probation
21	upon Whalen's licensure to commence from the date this order is signed by the
22	Commission and subject to the following condition:
23	 Whalen shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical
24	Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules
25	Chapter 584, Division 020.
