

1 October 26, 2023. During all relevant times, Llewellyn was employed by the Lake
2 Oswego High School (LOSD).

3
4 2. On March 25, 2021, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC)
5 received a School District Misconduct report from the Executive Director of the Lake
6 Oswego School District, Donna Atherton. The report alleged that Llewellyn was
7 engaged in an “on-going” sexual relationship with a 17 year-old girl from another
8 school district. The report indicates Llewellyn was placed on administrative leave
9 pending the outcome of both a district and criminal investigation.

10
11 3. Investigation by the Sandy Police Department (SPD) (SPD Report 20-1316) revealed
12 the following:

- 13
- 14 • Llewellyn met MA, a 16 year-old female in late 2019. When Llewellyn met
15 MA, he was 43 years old.
- 16 • MA presented to Llewellyn that she was 22 years old when they first met,
17 but shortly after Llewellyn met MA in person, Llewellyn discovered that
18 she was under that age of 18.
- 19 • Llewellyn engaged in a sexual relationship with MA from approximately
20 December 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020.
- 21 • During this time frame, MA was 16 and 17 years old.
- 22 • During the criminal investigation, MA told investigating officers that the
23 sexual encounters with Llewellyn were often times rough. MA reported
24 that Llewellyn would occasionally hit her during sexual encounters and
25 would occasionally engage in bondage and choking activities.
- 26 • It was reported by witnesses that MA frequently had bruising on her arms,
27 neck, legs and face during this period.
- 28 • In early 2020, MA’s grandparents confronted Llewellyn about his
29 relationship with MA.
- 30 • Llewellyn confirmed to MA’s grandparents that he was aware of MA’s age
31 and dismissed their concerns about him having a relationship with her

1 despite her being 17 years old.

- 2 • MA's grandfather reported that Llewellyn told him that he had developed
- 3 feelings for MA and "could not end the affair."
- 4 • MA's friends also told investigators that they had met Llewellyn on several
- 5 occasions.
- 6 • MA's friend told investigators that MA had told them that she had engaged
- 7 in a sexual relationship with Llewellyn.
- 8 • MA's friends told investigators that MA had told them that she would
- 9 frequently get intoxicated around Llewellyn and that he would then do
- 10 "whatever he wanted" to her sexually.
- 11 • As a result of the criminal investigation, Llewellyn was subsequently
- 12 indicted on thirteen (13) counts of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree and
- 13 one (1) count of Contributing to the Sexual Dequincy of a Minor.
- 14 • Llewellyn pled guilty to one (1) count of Sexual Abuse in the Second
- 15 Degree on March 7, 2022.
- 16 • Llewellyn was sentenced to serve ninety (90) days in jail and sixty (60)
- 17 months of formal probation. Additionally, Llewellyn was required to
- 18 register as a sex offender with the Oregon State Police per Oregon state
- 19 law.

- 21 4. TSPC investigative staff made multiple attempts to contact Llewellyn for an
- 22 interview in July and August of 2023 at the listed contact phone numbers and
- 23 address. To date, as of the writing of this Default Order, neither Llewellyn nor his
- 24 attorney of record have responded to TSPC's efforts to contact him.

26 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

27 The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS

28 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1)

29 (*Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual*),

30 OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e)

31 (*Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations*); OAR 584-020-

32 0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(b) (*Refrain from exploiting*

33 *professional relationships with any student for personal gain, or in support of*

1 persons or issues), OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(A) (Not demonstrating or expressing
2 professionally inappropriate interest in a student's personal life), and OAR 584-
3 020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in
4 conduct and conversations at all times). **Additionally, Under ORS 342.175(2)**
5 **and OAR 584, Division 020, the Commission will deny, revoke or deny**
6 **the right to apply for a license or charter school registration to any**
7 **applicant or educator who, has been convicted of any of the crimes**
8 **listed in ORS 342.143, or the substantial equivalent of any of those**
9 **crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction or convicted of attempt to**
10 **commit such crimes as defined in 161.405.**

13 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based
14 upon ORS 342.175.

15 **FINAL ORDER**

16 The Commission hereby revokes Llewellyn's Oregon teaching license and his
17 right to apply for an Oregon teaching license.
