On May 17, 2021, the Commission received a School District Misconduct Report from 1 2) 2 the superintendent of the SHSD. The report indicated that on May 12, 2021, Bascom, School Counselor at the Sweet Home Junior High School (SHJHS), was arrested for 3 4 Criminal Trespass in the second degree. 5 Investigation determined that on May 11, 2020, Bascom was asked by her supervisor 6 3) to comply with district/state facemask requirements. Via district email, later the 7 same day, Bascom explained to her supervisor why she had an issue with the masking 8 requirement. The following day, on May 12, 2020, Bascom reported for work, but 9 ultimately opted to cancel her appointments and remain alone in her office. At 10 1:15PM Bascom was given a directive from her supervisor to leave campus based on 11 her non-compliance with the masking requirement. At 1:50PM, the Sweet Home 12 Police Department responded to the school. At that time, Bascom was informed she 13 was being placed on administrative leave and needed to leave the building. Bascom 14 was told that if she did not leave, she would be arrested and charged with 15 Trespassing. Bascom did not comply and was arrested and removed from campus. 16 The district placed Bascom on administrative leave until the expiration of her 17 contract, June 30, 2020. 18 19 On September 14, 2021, Bascom interviewed with TSPC Investigative staff. During 20 4) that interview, Bascom stated that she is not against COVID vaccines or masks but 21 merely had strong convictions against not wearing one outside and with students or 22 alone in her office. Bascom reported that she felt the only way she could leave her 23 office without wearing a mask was by being arrested and escorted out of the building 24 by police. Bascom reported feeling trapped and stated there was a lot of 25 miscommunication between her and district staff that day. 26 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** 27 The above conduct described in section two (2) above, constitutes gross neglect of 28

duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it
