8	On July 11, 2024, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
9	(Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Jaime V. Cancino
10	(Cancino) in which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty and/or
11	Gross Unfitness. The Notice was sent via U.S. First-Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail
12	Receipt 9589 0710 5270 2162 7855 70 to the address on file with the Commission. The
13	Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima
14	facie case. The return receipt for the Notice sent Certified Mail was signed, and then
15	received by the Commission on July 15, 2024. The regular First-Class mail was not
16	returned to the Commission and assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of
17	Hearing, dated July 11, 2024, and signed by Melissa Goff, Interim Executive Director,
18	stated:

IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, OR IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE."
29	On August 30, 2024, Cancino's attorney sent the Commission an email indicating
30	Cancino would not contest the matter. The Commission, therefore, finds Cancino to be
31	in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order,
32	based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
33	
34	FINDINGS OF FACT
35	1. The Commission has licensed Cancino since August 29, 2006. Cancino held a
36	Preliminary Teaching License, with endorsements in Elementary – Multiple

Subjects (PK-12) and English to Speakers of Other Languages (PK-12), valid from June 8, 2021, through June 7, 2024.

2. On October 27, 2021, the Commission received information from the Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS) reporting Cancino allegedly engaged in an inappropriate sexual relationship with a minor for approximately ten years. On November 9, 2021, the Commission received a misconduct report from the Woodburn School District (WSD) indicating Cancino may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. The district reported Cancino was being investigated for allegations of sexual abuse.

3. Investigation found that on October 29, 2021, the WSD placed Cancino on administrative leave after the District learned of the allegations of sexual conduct against Cancino.

4. Investigation found that on unspecified dates from approximately 2000 to 2010, Cancino engaged in sexual conduct with a minor on approximately six occasions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Jaime V. Cancino's conduct as described in section four (4) above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f) (Any sexual conduct with a student) as defined by OAR 584-020-0005(8) and ORS 339.370(12)(a).

Jaime V. Cancino's conduct as described in section four (4) above, constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(3)(c) and (d) as defined by OAR 584-020-0040 (5) (Gross unfitness is any conduct which renders an educator unqualified to perform his or her professional responsibilities), and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even in the absence of a conviction).

The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

2	The Commission hereby revokes Jaime V. Cancino's Oregon educator license.
