



1 Commission revoked Swanson-Suhrstedt's right to apply for an Oregon educator license. On
2 January 8, 2014, Swanson-Suhrstedt declined to request a hearing and on January 10, 2014, the
3 Commission adopted a default order.

5 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 6 1. On March 24, 2022, Swanson-Suhrstedt submitted an application to the Commission for
7 reinstatement of her Oregon teaching license. On April 4, 2022, an investigation was opened
8 to determine Swanson-Suhrstedt's fitness for reinstatement. On May 3, 2022, Swanson-
9 Suhrstedt was interviewed by Commission investigators.
- 10 2. On June 22, 2022, the Commission considered Swanson-Suhrstedt's application,
11 investigative report, and support materials.
- 12 3. On August 22, 2022, Swanson-Suhrstedt notified the Commission by letter that she was
13 requesting her application for reinstatement be withdrawn.



26 The Commission hereby accepts Swanson-Suhrstedt's request to withdraw her
27 application for reinstatement.

30 Swanson-Suhrstedt can apply for reinstatement.
