



4 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 5 1. On June 30, 2022, van Haalen digitally signed and submitted an application with the
6 Commission for an Oregon Administrator License. Van Haalen's application was placed on
7 hold pending resolution of this matter.
8
- 9 2. In August 2022, Commission staff reviewed van Haalen's application and during a
10 background check, found additional publicly available information that was inconsistence
11 with information provided by van Haalen on his application.
12
- 13 3. A Commission investigator attempted to contact van Haalen in July 2023, to arrange an
14 interview. The interview was to cover the information from van Haalen's background which
15 would allow the Commission to more thoughtfully assess his fitness to hold an Oregon
16 teaching license or Charter School Registry. Van Haalen contacted the investigator on
17 August 1, 2023, and indicated he no longer wished to obtain licensure from the Commission.
18 The investigator informed van Haalen an interview was still required, and van Haalen
19 declined to participate in an interview or further cooperate in the investigation.

34 neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as incorporates
35 OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(p) (*Subject to*
36 *the exercise of any legal right or privilege, failure or refusal by an educator under*
37 *investigation to respond to request for information, to furnish or to participate in interviews*

1 with a Commission representative relating to a Commission investigation).


2 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
