

1 3. Investigation found that on October 10, 2022, Carter was upset over issues of student and
2 staff safety which were posed by one student’s ongoing behavior. After Carter’s second-grade
3 class were under the supervision of the physical education teacher for their physical
4 education period, Carter contacted the front office and informed them she was quitting and
5 left the campus.

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7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 Jolie A. Carter’s conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of
9 duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-
10 020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0020(2)(d) (*Skill in the supervision*
11 *of students*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (*Using district lawful and reasonable rule and*
12 *regulations*); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(2)(b) (*Conduct*
13 *professional business, including grievances, through established lawful and reasonable*
14 *procedures*).


15 The Commission’s authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
16 342.175.

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18 **FINAL ORDER**

19 The Commission hereby imposes a Public Reprimand upon Jolie A. Carter’s Oregon
20 educator license.
