





1 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

- 3 1. The Commission first licensed Bunch on May 19, 2011. Bunch held an Initial I Teaching  
4 License, with endorsements in Multiple Subjects – Middle Level, and Biology – Middle  
5 Level and High School, valid from May 19, 2011, through April 15, 2015.
- 6
- 7 2. On January 10, 2012, the Commission received information alleging Bunch violated  
8 teacher/student boundaries during the 2011-12 school year. The Commission opened an  
9 investigation and founded the allegations. On July 26, 2013, the Commission issued a  
10 Stipulation of Facts, Final Order of Surrender and Revocation of Bunch’s Oregon teaching  
11 license.

- 13 3. On September 12, 2023, the Commission received Bunch’s application for reinstatement  
14 of his Oregon teaching license. In subsequent days, Bunch provided documentation  
15 required for the reinstatement process, additional, non-required documents to support  
16 his application, and he participated in an interview with a Commission investigator.

- 18 4. On February 2, 2024, Bunch’s request for reinstatement came before the Commission.  
19 The Commission determined Bunch was eligible for reinstatement with a period of  
20 probation with conditions.

32 **FINAL ORDER**

33 The Commission hereby grants Kyle E. Bunch’s reinstatement for an Oregon educator  
34 license.

35 Furthermore, the Commission imposes a period of two (2) years of probation upon  
36 Bunch’s license to commence upon issuance of Bunch’s Oregon educator license, and subject to

1 the following terms and conditions of probation:

- 3 1. Bunch shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance of  
4 Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division 020.
  - 5
  - 6 2. Bunch will be required to successfully complete and provide evidence of Commission-  
7 approved trainings on classroom management and teacher/student boundaries, to  
8 commence within six (6) months upon issuance of this order.
  - 9

10 Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for  
11 the Commission to revoke Bunch's Oregon educator license or otherwise impose discipline, after  
12 first providing Bunch with notice and opportunity for hearing.

13 Now therefore, the Commission orders that Kyle Bunch's right to apply for an Oregon  
14 educator license is hereby reinstated effective April 5, 2024.
