Social Studies. During all relevant times, Mr. Chism was employed by the Reedsport School District. 2. On May 28, 2008, Mr. Chism roughly grabbed and restrained, by their clothing, two seventh-grade male students. On the same day, Mr. Chism roughly grabbed another male student by the wrist. These two incidents occurred after an October 26, 2007 verbal directive that Mr. Chism avoid touching students except in specific safety situations. On June 11, 2008, he received a written directive to refrain from touching students or treating them roughly. 3. On May 11, 2009, Mr. Chism grabbed a male student by the arm and forcefully removed the student from the classroom. The student indicated that he felt pain where Mr. Chism held his arm. **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** Theodore Alexander Chism's rough handling of two students on May 28, 2008, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0030(3)(d) (Skill in reconciling conflict). Mr. Chism's physical conduct with a student on May 11, 2009, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(d) (Unreasonable physical force against students, fellow employees, or visitors to the school, except as permitted under ORS 339.250). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175. 

**FINAL ORDER** The Commission hereby imposes a Reprimand on Theodore Alexander Chism's educator license. IT IS SO ORDERED THIS / day of May, 2010.
