## 1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND Teaching License of FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION ) 5 JAMES JOSEPH RUSSO OF RIGHT TO APPLY FOR LICENSURE 6 On or about December 16, 2004, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 7 (Commission) received a report from Carol Miller, Secretary, Salem-Keizer Public Schools indicating 8 that James Joseph Russo (Russo) while substituting at Bush College Elementary, was recognized by a 9 district employee as a person who made improper sexual advances toward her and a friend in the mid-10 70's, when they were young girls acquainted with Mr. Russo in the community. After review of the matters alleged, Russo and the Commission agree that their respective 11 12 interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and 13 revocation of his right to apply for licensure. This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated 14 sanction to be imposed. Russo stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files 15 and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below. 16 By signing below, Russo acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: 17 (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, 18 conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights 19 to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Revocation of Right to 20 Apply (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and 21 disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is 22 contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does 23 not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Mr. Russo nor the Commission 24 are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands 25 it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final 26 Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no 27 promises or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and 28

| 5              | STIPULATION OF FACTS   |
| 6              | 1) The Commission has licensed James Joseph Russo since July 1, 1973. The Commission issued  |
| 7              | a Basic Teaching to Mr. Russo with a Basic Elementary endorsement on January 8, 2004,  |
| 8              | which expired on January 27, 2007. Mr. Russo is retired from teaching.   |
| 9              | 2) It was reported to the Commission that Mr. Russo made improper sexual advances toward two   |
| 0              | girls in the community in the 1970's.  |
| 1              | 3) Mr. Russo was alleged to have engaged in a sexual relationship with one of the girls beginning  |
| 2              | when she was approximately 9-10 years old and continuing for approximately a year and a  |
| 3              | half.  |
| 4              | 4) The second girl alleged that Mr. Russo made an attempt to engage in sexual activity with her,   |
| 5              | but she successfully repulsed his attempt.   |
| 6              | 5) During the time of these incidents Mr. Russo was licensed by the Commission. Neither of the   |
| 7              | girls involved were students of Mr. Russo.   |
| 8              | 6) Mr. Russo does not admit these allegations; however, he agrees that the Commission has  |
| 19             | sufficient evidence to revoke his right to apply for licensure.  |
