7	On October 4, 2001, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission)		
8	issued a denial of the application of Gregory Dale Bruce for an Oregon Teaching License. Mr.		
9	Bruce requested a hearing to contest the denial of his license. The Commission and Mr. Bruce		
10	have now reviewed the matters alleged and have agreed that their respective interests, together		
11	with the public interests, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the issuance of a		
12	teaching license on a probationary basis, together with a public reprimand. This agreement sets		
13	forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the Commission's order.		
14	This stipulation is contingent on approval and adoption of the order by the Commission.		
15	If the Commission does not adopt this order, neither Mr. Bruce nor the Commission are bound		
16	by any matters herein, and Mr. Bruce will retain all rights to a hearing on the allegations of the		
17	notice.		
18	STIPULATED FACTS		
19	Mr. Bruce and the Commission stipulate as follows:		
20	1. On March 13, 2000, Mr. Bruce st	ubmitted an application for a teaching license to	
21	the Commission. In the application, Mr. Bruce acknowledged that he had been convicted of a		
22	major traffic violation.

1	2. On December 3, 1999, Mr. Bruce entered a plea of guilty and was convicted of		
2	the crime of driving under the influence of intoxicants in South Kern, California Municipal		
3	Court. He was placed on probation to the court for a period of three years and ordered to serve		
4	two days in custody. He was also required to pay a fine of \$1,230, to participate in an		
5	alcohol/drug education program, and his driver's license was conditionally suspended.

12	CONCLUSION OF LAW		
13	Mr. Bruce was convicted of driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of		
14	intoxicants in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c).		
15	ORDER		
16	The Commission adopts the above findings of fact and orders a public reprimand for		
17	conviction of driving under the influence of intoxicants. This order shall serve as the public		
18	reprimand.		
19	The Commission authorizes issuance of an Oregon Teaching License to Mr. Bruce and		
20	places Mr. Bruce on probation for a period of two years subject to the following conditions:		
21	1. Mr. Bruce shall comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical		
22	Performance of Oregon Educators under OAR 584 Division 020.

3	3. Mr. Bruce shall promptly report in writing to the Commission if he is arrested or	
4	charged with any crime or major traffic violation.	
5	Violation of any of the terms of probation shall constitute an independent basis for the	
6	Commission to revoke Mr. Bruce's teaching license or otherwise impose discipline after first	
7	providing Mr. Bruce with notice and an opportunity for a hearing on the issue of whether he has	
8	violated any term of probation
