1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 STATE OF OREGON 3 STIPULATION OF FACTS In the Matter of the Teaching License of: 4 FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND **BRUCE SHULL** 5 On August 21, 2008, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received б a information that the St. Paul School district had employed a math teacher without proper licensure. 7 Mr. Shull fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation in to the matter. After review 8 of the matters alleged, Mr. Shull and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together 9 with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and a public reprimand. 10 This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated 11 sanction to be imposed. Mr. Shull stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files 12 and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below. 13 By signing below, Mr. Shull acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 14 following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of 15 fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any 16 rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reprimand 17 (Stipulation and Final Order), (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed 18 to the public upon request by the Commission, (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon 19 and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 20 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Mr. Shull nor the Commission are bound by the 21 terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) 22 he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to 23 issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or 24 representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 25 26

consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with 1 regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering 2 into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. This 3 Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Mr. 4 Shull stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to 5 support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, 6 Mr. Shull waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set 7 8 forth below. 9 STIPULATION OF FACTS Mr. Shull currently holds a Continuing Administrative License issued 5/22/2008, valid until 10 1. 5/21/2013, with Administrator endorsements at all levels. Mr. Shull has served as 11 Superintendent of the St. Paul School District since July 1, 2002. 12 While serving as Superintendent of the District in 2007-08, Mr. Shull recommended and the 13 2. school board approved the hiring of Chris Milliron as a math teacher for St. Paul High School 14 on August 8, 2007. The high school principal, Debbie Eder and Supt. Shull discussed during 15 the interview with Chris Milliron the need for him to obtain an emergency teaching license 16 17 from TSPC. Mr. Milliron did not obtain proper licensure. The matter was brought to the attention of Mr. 18 3. Shull in August 2008 after Mr. Milliron learned from TSPC that he was not properly licensed. 19 Mr. Shull immediately contacted TSPC to inquire about a corrective course of action for the 20 4. failure to have Mr. Milliron properly licensed. The corrective action resulted in Mr. Milliron 21 receiving an expedited license to teach Math. Mr. Shull took full responsibility for the 22 oversight and demonstrated there was no attempt to purposely evade licensing requirements. 23 24 /// 25 /// 26 ///

9	incorporates OAR 584-020-0025(3)(a).

11	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact, conclusions of law
12	and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Bruce A. Shull. This Order shall serve as the
13	Public Reprimand.
