PETERSEN 6 SUSPENSION OF RIGHT TO APPLY 7 On June 4, 2012, the Commission received an application for reinstatement of 8 the expired license of Harold Viby Petersen (Petersen). Discrepancies in Petersen's 9 application resulted in a referral to professional practices for an investigation to 10 determine if Petersen had violated professional standards. 11 After review of the matters alleged, Petersen and the Commission agree that their 12 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 13 certain facts and the imposition of a denial of application and suspension of right to 14 15 apply. By signing below, Petersen acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 16 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest 17 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 18 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 19 Facts and Final Order of Denial and Suspension (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this 20 Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon 21 request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and 22 subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not 23 approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Petersen nor the 24 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and 25 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or 26 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of 27 the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has 28 been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 29 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 30 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an 31 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of 32 33 the Stipulated Final Order below. STIPULATION OF FACTS 34 1. Harold Viby Petersen has been licensed by the Commission since August 22, 1984 35

Petersen's Standard Teaching License, with endorsements in Standard Elementary (014),

- Basic Technology Education (018) and Construction (024), was issued on November 3, 1997, and expired on June 6, 2003. Petersen did not submit an application for renewal prior to the application submitted on June 4, 2012. Petersen is not currently employed by any known Oregon School District.
 - 2. A review of Petersen's application noted Petersen answered "No" to all the application's character questions and signed and dated the form on May 29, 2012. Petersen answered "No" to question number four (4), "Have you ever had any adverse action taken on a professional certificate, license or charter school registration?"; and question number six (6), "Have you every surrendered a professional license of any kind before its expiration?", and question number seven (7), "Have you ever been disciplined by any public agency responsible for licensure of any kind, including but not limited to educational licensure?" The Commission discovered during the background check portion of Petersen's application processes that Petersen's California teaching credential was revoked in 1996 for failure to report to work after signing a contract.
 - 3. Commission investigators questioned Petersen about the discrepancy. Petersen advised that he had hurried through the application and as a result, failed to answer the questions accurately. Petersen explained that his prior, 1995-1996, discipline by the California Commission was a result of Petersen not returning to work after a layoff period, which was a violation of his teaching contract. Petersen advised that he chose not to fight the California discipline and "defaulted" during the process, resulting in his California Credential being revoked. This was verified through documents from the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Harold Viby Petersen falsely answered the character questions in his application to the Commission for reinstatement. This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in

1	violation of ORS 342.175 (1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-
2	020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c) (Knowing
3	falsification of any document or knowing misrepresentation directly related to
4	licensure, employment, or professional duties). This conduct also constitutes a violation
5	of ORS 342.175(1)(e); OAR 584-050-0006(3)(a), (Notice of denial and right to a
6	hearing may be issued by the Executive Director when any of the following conditions
7	exist: The applicant submits a falsified application).
8	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
9	ORS 342.175.
0	ORDER
1	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
2	conclusions of law, and based thereon, denies Harold Viby Petersen's application for
13	reinstatement and imposes a six month suspension of his right to apply for a license to
14	begin following the adoption of this order.
