BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 3 In the Matter of the FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND 4 Teaching License of) 5 CHARLES FRITZ JUENGLING 6 7 On April 19, 2011, the Commission received information from Superintendent 8 Husk of the Salem-Keizer School District regarding Charles Fritz Juengling (Juengling). Husk reported that Juengling had been locally investigated for misuse of district time 9 10 and resources, and had received student complaints regarding Juengling's classroom 11 management techniques. 12 After review of the matters alleged, Juengling and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a 13 14 stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand. By signing below, Juengling acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 15 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest 16 17 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 18 19 Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation 20 and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to 21 approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 22 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Juengling nor the Commission are 23 24 bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and 25 understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into 26 this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated 27 Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an 28 29 attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior 30 to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated 31 32 Final Order below. 33 STIPULATION OF FACTS 1. Charles Fritz Juengling has been licensed by the Commission since August 7, 1989. 34 35 Juengling currently holds a Standard Teaching License, with an endorsement in Standard German (018) and Standard Language Arts (020); issued June 7, 2007, and 36

- valid through June 6, 2012. During all relevant times, Juengling was employed by the
 Salem-Keizer School District.
 - 2. On April 19, 2011, the Commission received a report from the Salem-Keizer School district advising that Juengling had been investigated locally regarding allegations of misuse of District time and resources as well as student complaints regarding Juengling's teaching methods.
 - 3. The Commission's investigation determined that Juengling used the district's computer and internet resources to surf the internet for a variety of purposes, both personal and school related. Juengling admitted to at times, using these resources during work time, outside his preparation times and breaks. Juengling also admitted that he used these resources for personal reasons, (check email, buy and sell hobby items, read news articles, check sports scores, etcetera) as well as to search for and purchase materials for his classroom (movies and other materials in the German language). These assertions appear supported by the tracking materials and logs supplied by the school district. There is no evidence that any illicit sites were visited.

This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(a) (Knowing and substantial unauthorized use of: school name or financial credit; school materials or equipment for personal purposes; or school personnel to provide personal services unrelated to school business), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(b) (Knowing and

1	substantial unauthorized use of employment time or school resources for private
2	purposes).
3	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
4	ORS 342.175.
5	ORDER
6	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
7	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Charles Fritz
8	Juengling's Standard Teaching License.
