BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 STIPULATION OF FACTS AND In the Matter of the) FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND 4 Educator License of 5) LORI MICHELE REZNICK 6 On November 21, 2103, the Commission received a report alleging that Lori 7 8 Michele Reznick (Reznick) had violated professional standards. 9 After review of the matters alleged, Reznick and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 10 11 certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand. 12 By signing below, Reznick acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to 13 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and 14 finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this 15 Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) 16 this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon 17 request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and 18 subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not 19 approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Reznick nor the 20 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and 21 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or 22 23 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has 24 been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has 25 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 26 advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an 27 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of 28 29 the Stipulated Final Order below. 30 STIPULATION OF FACTS 1. Lori Michele Reznick has been licensed by the Commission since September 11, 1984. 31 Reznick's Basic Teaching License, with an endorsement Elementary – Multiple Subjects 32 (PK-12), is valid from August 4, 2015 through August 3, 2018. During all relevant times, 33 Reznick was employed by the Gresham-Barlow School District.

- 2. On November 21, 2013, the Commission received a report from the Gresham-Barlow 1 2 School District alleging she had violated professional standards involving testing improprieties in the course of administering an Oregon Assessment of Knowledge and 3 4 Skills (OAKS) test by making comments that under the testing manual could be considered "Coaching" or unauthorized assistance, such as "Use common sense" or "If 5 that's your answer you can move on." 7 3. Reznick also, during the latter part of the test, had the students bring their laptops to her when a student had a question or when a student thought they had completed the test. If 8 9 one student was already at her desk when one or more other students arrived, then the 10 other students would leave their computers and Reznick would call those students back 11 to her desk individually when she was ready to either reread a question or ask if the 12 student was ready to end the test. 13 4. Reznick had signed the form indicating that it was her responsibility to follow the procedures in the 2012-13 Test Administration Manual. Based upon the interviews of 14 eight of the involved students, the district recommended that the entire testing session 15 16 be invalidated. 8	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Lori Michele
9	Reznick's Teaching License.
