## BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON STIPULATION OF FACTS, 3 In the Matter of the AND FINAL ORDER OF 4 **Teaching License of** ) **BRIAN LEE SAY** 5 ) On or about January 18, 2008, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 6 (Commission) received a report for the Interim Superintendent of the Umatilla School District, 7 Heidi Sipe, informing the Commission that former Superintendent Brian Lee Say may not have 8 reported a teacher for an incident of unreasonable physical force against a student. 9 After review of the matters alleged, Say and the Commission agree that their respective 10 interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and 11 the imposition of a one year suspension of licensure. It is understood and agreed that this 12 stipulation fully and finally resolves any and all matters now known to the Commission 13 regarding Say's failure to report educators' alleged misconduct, which occurred or of which he 14 became aware of while Say was Superintendent of Umatilla School District, that it might regard 15 16 as the basis for discipline against Say. This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated 17 sanction to be imposed. Say stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files 18 and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below. 19 20 By signing below, Say acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the 21 findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all 22 such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts, Order of 23 Suspension (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public 24 document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and 25 Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the 26 Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Say nor 27 the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final 28

- 1 Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final 2 Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce him to 3 sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this 4 Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or 5 waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and 6 Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. This stipulation is 7 8 contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Say nor the Commission are bound by these Stipulations and 9 10 Say retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations. STIPULATION OF FACTS 11 1. The Commission has licensed Brian Lee Say since January 17, 1986. Say currently holds 12 a Standard Administrative License, with Standards Administrator and Standard 13 Superintendent endorsements, issued January 31, 2005 and valid through January 16, 14 15 2010. Say timely applied for renewal of his license which was pending the outcome of 16 this investigation. 2. On January 17, 2008 the Interim Superintendent of the Umatilla School District 17 reported that upon taking over as Superintendent she found several disciplinary matters 18 and allegations of misconduct that she could not find a record of having been reported to 19
  - the Commission. Specifically,
    - a. A first year probationary male teacher allegedly made inappropriate comments with sexual overtones to students. The same teacher allegedly hit a female student on the buttocks with a ruler. These issues were investigated and the teacher subsequently resigned after one year from the district.
    - b. Say was aware of allegations of a sexual relationship that occurred some years prior between a male teacher then serving the district and a female student.
    - c. Say did not report these incidents to the Commission.

7	CONCLUSION OF LAW
8	Brian Lee Say served failed to report suspected misconduct of at least two educators
9	while serving as Superintendent of the Umatilla School District. This conduct constitutes gross
10	neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates
11	OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0041(3) (A chief
12	administrator will report to the Executive Director within thirty (30) days the name of any
13	person described in subsection (2) above, when the chief administrator reasonably believes the
14	person may have committed any act which may constitute any of the designated acts of gross
15	neglect of duty under OAR 584-020-0040(4), subsections (a) to (i), (k) to (o) or (q) or any of
16	the designated acts of gross unfitness listed under OAR 584-020-0040(5), subsections (a) to
17	(e)). The Commission has the authority to impose discipline in this matter under ORS 342.120
18	through 342.430 and OAR Chapter 584.
19	FINAL ORDER
20	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
21	conclusion of law, based thereon, hereby suspends the Standard Administrator License of Brian
22	Lee Say for 1 year.
