| 10 | issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Janet L Montgomery (Montgomery) in which the |
| 11 | Commission charged her with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class |
| 12 | Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7011 2000 0001 1292 0073 to the address on file with the |
| 13 | Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a |
| 14 | prima facie case. The Certified Mail was returned to the Commission marked "Unclaimed" on |
| 15 | January 8, 2013. The regular mail was not returned to the Commission. The Notice of |
| 16 | Opportunity of Hearing, dated December 21, 2012, and signed by Victoria Chamberlain, |
| 17 | Executive Director, stated: |
| 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 | "IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING OR IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE." |
| 26 | Montgomery did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Montgomery to be in |
| 27 | default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on |
| 28 | the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter. |
| 29 | FINDINGS OF FACT |
| 30 | 1. Janet L Montgomery has been licensed by the Commission since August 21, 2001. |
| 31 | Montgomery's Initial II Teaching License, with an endorsement in Multiple Subjects Self- |
| 32 | Contained (ECE, ELE), was issued August 22, 2011, and expires on May 1, 2015. During all |
| 33 | relevant times, Montgomery was employed by the North Clackamas School District. |
| 34 | 2. On April 2, 2012, Montgomery was approached by an eight-year-old female student, MM. MM |
| 35 | disclosed to Montgomery that her father had struck her in the mouth, causing her pain and her |
| 36 | mouth to bleed. Montgomery noted that MM's lip was cut but not actively bleeding at the time of the |
| 37 | report. Montgomery, knowing the disclosure was a reportable event, made a note of the incident |
| 38 | and placed it on her computer because, in Montgomery's own words; "it was urgent". Montgomery |
| 39 | failed to report the possible child abuse to DHS or local law enforcement until 25 days later. |

| 6 | The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon |

| 9 | The Commission hereby issues a Thirty (30) day suspension upon Janet L Montgomery's |
| 10 | Educator licensure. |
