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STIPULATION OF FACTS AND ORDER OF PROBATION

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1. Mr. Rollins holds a Transitional Teaching License with Basic Mathematics, Basic Physical Education and Basic Health Education Endorsements effective July 17, 2000, valid until July 17, 2003.

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2. Mr. Rollins was employed by Molalla River School District as a Math Teacher at Molalla High School from August 2000 until June of 2001.

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3. Mr. Rollins was employed by Dallas School District as a High School Teacher from August 28, 2001 until dismissal effective November 30, 2001.

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4. Scott McLeod was Mr. Rollins' supervisor at Dallas High School. In the fall of 2001, Mr. McLeod received information that caused him to be concerned about Mr. Rollins' communication with a student at Molalla High School.

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5. When questioned by Mr. McLeod, Mr. Rollins stated that he had had very little contact with the student and had not spoken to the student about any of the student's personal issues. In fact, after leaving Molalla High School, Mr. Rollins had communicated with the student about the student's personal relationships and similar issues.

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2 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

3 Hardie Scott Rollins failed to acknowledge to his supervisor the extent of his
4 contacts with a high school student and the nature of his discussions with the student.
5 This misconduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of OAR 584-020-
6 0040(4)(c).

7 **ORDER**

8 Based upon the foregoing, the Commission places Mr. Rollins on probation for a
9 period of two years, subject to the following conditions:

10 1. Mr. Rollins shall, at his own expense, engage in training concerning
11 appropriate professional boundaries through a qualified trainer, approved in advance by
12 the Commission. Such counseling shall include at least eight (8) one-hour sessions.
13 Mr. Rollins will provide the trainer with a copy of this Order and the District's report to
14 the Commission. The trainer will provide the Commission with a report of successful
15 program completion.

16 2. Mr. Rollins shall comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical
17 Performance under Chapter OAR 584, Division 020.

18 Violation of the terms of this probation may constitute an independent basis for
19 the Commission to impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Mr. Rollins'
20 teaching license, subject to Mr. Rollins' right to a hearing on the issue of whether he
21 violated probation.
