## 1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 Teaching License of FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND 5 GERALD DALE HOLLIS On or about January 13, 2010, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 8 (Commission) received a report from the Bend-LaPine School District, indicating Gerald 9 Dale Hollis (Hollis), acted aggressively and put a physical hold on a student. 10 After review of the matters alleged, Hollis and the Commission agree that their 11 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 12 certain facts, and the imposition of a Public Reprimand on Hollis's Standard Teaching 13 License. 14 By signing below, Hollis acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 15 following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the 16 findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 17 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 18 Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation 19 and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request to the 20 Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to 21 approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 22 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Hollis nor the Commission are 23 bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and 24 understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into 25 this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated 26 Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to 27 induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an 28 attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with

- 1 regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior
- 2 to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated
- 3 Final Order below.

## STIPULATION OF FACTS

- 1. The Commission has licensed Hollis since May 19, 2003. Hollis currently holds a Limited Teaching License, with an endorsement in ROTC (pp-12), issued on May 20, 2009, and valid until May 19, 2012. During all relevant times, Hollis was employed by the Bend-La Pine School District.
- 2. On or about December 2, 2009, Hollis placed a male student in what the student described as a choke hold. Hollis denied that it was a choke hold. After the student requested that Hollis release him, Hollis complied. Witnesses report that Hollis then told the student to "get the hell out of here" or words to that effect. Witnesses report that Hollis was angry and engaged in this conduct following the student's questioning of pushups that Hollis was performing.
- 3. Following the above described incident, the district interviewed students regarding Hollis' behavior. Students reported that Hollis engaged in pinching students, twisting ears, grabbing and lifting students by their belts, swatting students in the back of the head, twisting male students' nipples, grabbing the underwear of male students and pulling upward. Students report that this conduct occurred both in a playful manner and as a means of redirecting behavior or getting students' attention.
- 4. Students reported that Hollis wrestled with them. At times such wrestling has resulted in injury to students such as; testicle grabs, scratches, and ripped clothing.
- 5. Students also reported that Hollis used inappropriate language and vulgarities when speaking with them.

18	(Use professional judgment), OAR $584-020-0020(2)(d)$ (Skill in the supervision of students),
19	OAR $584$ -020-0040(4)(d) (Unreasonable physical force against students, fellow employees, or
20	visitors to the school, except as permitted under ORS 339.250).
21	Hollis' use of inappropriate language with students constitutes gross neglect of duty in
22	violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-
23	0010(1) (Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR
24	584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0020(2)(d)(Skill in the
25	supervision of students), OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-
26	0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and

conversations at all times), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(d) (Unreasonable physical force
against students, fellow employees, or visitors to the school, except as permitted under ORS
339.250).
ORDER
The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Gerald Dale
Hollis' Limited Teaching License.
