4 regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights  
5 thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this  
6 Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. This  
7 Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed.  
8 Mr. Fehr stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and  
9 records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into  
10 this stipulation, Mr. Fehr waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions  
11 of law and order set forth below.


12 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

13 1. The Commission has licensed Mr. Fehr since June 7, 2004. Mr. Fehr currently holds  
14 an Initial I Teaching License valid August 27, 2007 through November 2, 2010 with an  
15 endorsement in special education. He is employed by the Medford School District.

16 2. On February 21, 1980, Mr. Fehr was convicted in Lane County District Court of two  
17 counts of Theft II, a Class A Misdemeanor.

18 3. On two applications for licensure, the first submitted on March 28, 2004, and the  
19 second on August 1, 2007, Mr. Fehr failed to disclose these prior convictions.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Gregg Alan Fehr, a teacher with the Medford School District, failed to disclose a conviction on two applications for educator licensure. This conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c) (*Knowing falsification or misrepresentation*) and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*). The Commission has the authority to impose discipline in this matter under ORS 342.120 through 342.430 and OAR Chapter 584.

**FINAL ORDER**

The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above finding of facts, conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Gregg Alan Fehr. This Order shall serve as the Public Reprimand.
