CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Julia Ann Paige's conviction for Delivery of Less than Five Grams of Marijuana is a conviction requiring revocation of her license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2); ORS 342.143(3)(A); and constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(1)(ww); and ORS 475.860 (*Unlawful delivery of marijuana*).

FINAL ORDER

The Commission hereby revokes Julia Ann Paige's right to apply for a teaching license. IT IS SO ORDERED THIS 14th day of May, 2010.
