

STIPULATION OF FACTS

1. The Commission has licensed Stephanie Anne Ostlund since May 7, 2008. Ostlund's current Initial II Teaching License with endorsements in Language Arts (HS, ML), Multiple Subjects (MIDLVL), and Middle School Social Studies (ML), was issued on December 4, 2011, and expires on December 3, 2014. During all relevant times, Ostlund was employed by the North Clackamas School District.
2. On December 12, 2012, the Commission received a report from the North Clackamas School District indicating Ostlund had violated professional standards involving testing improprieties by providing a student with the answers to a test. District and Commission investigations determined that on or about December 4, 2012, while monitoring a study hall, Ostlund improperly provided a student both the questions and answers to an online reading exam on the Accelerated Reader program by Renaissance Learning. The Accelerated Reader Program is not a State mandated testing program. When Ostlund was questioned about her conduct, Ostlund was not forthcoming in her responses.



CONCLUSION OF LAW

The above described conduct that Stephanie Anne Ostlund engaged in constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(2)(*Encourage scholarship*), OAR 584-020-0010(4)(*Raise educational standards*), OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-

1 0035(3)(a)(Maintain the dignity of the profession by respecting and obeying the law,
2 exemplifying personal integrity and honesty).

3 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
4 ORS 342.175.

5 **ORDER**

6 Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby orders as follows:

7 1. The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
8 conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Stephanie
9 Anne Ostlund's Educators License;


10 2. Ostlund is hereby placed on probation for a period of four (4) years from the date
11 this order is signed by the Commission subject to the following conditions:

12 a. Ostlund shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical
13 Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules
14 Chapter 584, Division 020.

15 Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for
16 the Commission to revoke Ostlund's teaching license, revoke her right to apply for a
17 license, or otherwise impose discipline, after first providing Ostlund with notice and
18 opportunity for hearing.
