BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS, SURRENDER, AND FINAL ORDER 4 Teaching License of 5 SHANE ELI COHN On or about October 6, 2008, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 8 (Commission) received a report indicating possible inappropriate conduct by Shane Eli 9 Cohn, a teacher in the Hillsboro School District. 10 After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Cohn and the Commission agree that 11 their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a 12 stipulation to certain facts and the surrender of his teaching license. 13 By signing below, Mr. Cohn acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees 14 to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to 15 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and 16 finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this 17 Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Revocation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this 18 Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon 19 request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and 20 subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not 21 approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Mr. Cohn nor the 22 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and 23 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or 24 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry 25 of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has 26 been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 27 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 28 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an

1 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of 2 the Stipulated Final Order below. 3 STIPULATION OF FACTS 4 1. The Commission has licensed Mr. Cohn since August 22, 2008. Mr. Cohn 5 currently holds an Initial I Teaching License, with endorsements in Language Arts 6 and Multiple Subjects, issued August 22, 2008, and valid through August 15, 7 2012. 8 2. Mr. Cohn was employed by the Hillsboro School District during the 2008-09 school year. 9 During the 2007-2008 school year, Mr. Cohn worked as a student teacher at the 10 Hillsboro School District's alternative school Miller Education Center. While working at 11 Miller Education Center, he met student CMS. After CMS was no longer a student at 12 Miller Education Center, Mr. Cohn developed a relationship with CMS that was deemed 13 inappropriate by Mr. Cohn's employer, the Hillsboro School District. 14 15 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 1/17/16

This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 26 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(A) 27 or (D) (Expressing professionally inappropriate interest in a student's personal life; Not

honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and conversations at all
