1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 DEFAULT ORDER OF 4 In the Matter of the Educator) REPRIMAND 5 License of) 6 JOANNE EILEEN CALLAWAY 7 8 On September 5, 2014, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 9 (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Joanne Eileen Callaway 10 (Callaway) in which the Commission charged her with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice 11 was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7012 1010 0003 2804 12 4647 to the address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file 13 as the record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail receipt was 14 returned to the Commission "signed" on September 11, 2014. The first class mail was not 15 returned to the Commission. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated September 5, 16 2014, and signed by Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director, stated: 17 "IF A REOUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY 18 PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED 19 UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR 20 REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING OR IF YOU 21 FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER 22 OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF 23 YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE." 24 25 Callaway did not requested a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Callaway to be in 26 default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based 27 on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter. 28 FINDINGS OF FACT 29 1. Callaway has been licensed by the Commission since October 31, 2007. Callaway's 30 Initial II Teaching License, with endorsements in Middle School Social Studies (ML), 31 Multiple Subjects (MIDLVL), and Multiple Subjects Self-Contained (ECE, ELE), was 32 issued on June 26, 2014, and expires on June 25, 2017. Callaway's Initial 33 34 Administrator License with an endorsement in Administrator (ALL LVL), was issued on November 11, 2010, and expired on June 25, 2014. Callaway made application for 35 renewal of her Initial Administrative License, but Callaway's application was 36

determined to be incomplete. During all relevant times, Callaway was employed by the Glide School District.

2. On January 21, 2014, the Commission received a report from the Glide School District indicating Callaway violated professional standards by falsely certifying teacher OAKS training. District and Commission investigations determined that during the 2013-2014 school year, Callaway failed to properly train and certify district educators in OAKS testing protocol as mandated. Callaway stated that because she was busy with other duties, Callaway was unable to properly certify all the teachers. Callaway requested that some teachers sign the OAKS "Test Administrator Assurance of Test Security" forms certifying they had "received test administration and security training for the current school year" even though they had not received the required training.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Joanne Eileen Callaway engaged in unprofessional conduct as described above. This conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(2)(Encourage scholarship), OAR 584-020-0010(4)(Raise educational standards), OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); OAR 584-020-0025(3)(a) (Leadership skills in managing the school, its students, staff, and programs as required by lawful and reasonable district policies, rules, and regulations, state and federal laws and regulations, and other programs as assigned, and assures that staff is informed of these requirements); and OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a)(Maintain the dignity of the profession by respecting and obeying the law, exemplifying personal integrity and honesty).

The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
