15	contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and		
16	finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this		
17	Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Suspension (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this

## 1 STIPULATION OF FACTS

- Whitney Galstad has been licensed as a teacher in Oregon since February 20, 2008. Her current Restricted Transitional Teaching License issued on February 20, 2008, expires on February 20, 2011.
  - 2. Galstad worked as an English teacher for the Hermiston School District and served in a temporary position as school counselor from January 2008 through June 2008. Galstad was hired by the Echo School District as an English teacher and school counselor for the 2008/2009 school year. During these times she held only a Transitional Teaching License with an endorsement in Language Arts at the high school level.
  - 3. On July 14, 2010 Galstad applied for an Initial I School counseling License. With this application Galstad attached a letter explaining that she was then under investigation because she "did not have the word 'career' in front of the job title as 'counselor' on [her] school blog or on [her] resume."
  - 4. On the resume submitted to the Commission on February 8, 2008, Galstad listed her career objective as "Obtain a position as a school counselor at Hermiston High School."
  - 5. On her resume submitted with her June 17, 2008 cover letter in support of her application to the Echo School District Galstad listed her career objective as "Obtain a Career/English teaching and counseling position within the Echo School District." Galstad under "Relevant Experience" listed "High School Counselor, Hermiston High School, January 2008-Jun 2008." As part of that experience Galstad wrote that she, "Provided guidance to students on an individual basis in the solution of problems". In her cover letter, Galstad wrote that she occupied a temporary counseling position at Hermiston High School and that her duties involved "guiding students in both academic and personal decisions..."
  - 6. During an interview with a Commission investigator Galstad denied serving as a school counselor despite the school so identifying her, and despite her own documentation to the contrary.

1 **CONCLUSION OF LAW** 2 Witney Leann Galstad served outside of her endorsement area when she accepted a 3 position as a school counselor first with the Hermiston School District and again when she 4 accepted such duties with the Echo School District. This conduct constitutes gross neglect of 5 duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-6 020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it incorporates 7 OAR 584-020-0035(2)(a) (Apply for, accept, offer, or assign a position of responsibility only 8 on the basis of professional qualifications, and will adhere to the conditions of a contract or the 9 terms of the appointment). 10 Galstad was untruthful with the Commission when interviewed about these allegations. 11 This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-12 0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment); and OAR 13 584-020-0040(4)(c) (Knowing falsification of any document or knowing misrepresentation 14 directly related to licensure, employment, or professional duties). 15 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon 16 ORS 342.175. 17 ORDER 18 The Commission hereby imposes a 30 day suspension on the licensure of 19 Whitney Leann Galstad.
