## BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 STIPULATION OF FACTS AND In the Matter of the FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND 4 Teaching License of 5 JONATHAN ROBERT LUEBKE 6 On June 1, 2011, the Commission referred Jonathan Robert Luebke (Luebke), to 7 8 investigation for teaching without a License or Charter School Registry. After review of the matters alleged, Luebke and the Commission agree that their 9 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 10 11 certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand. By signing below, Luebke acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 12 13 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 14 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 15 Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation 16 and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the 17 18 Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to 19 approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 20 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Luebke nor the Commission are 21 bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and 22 understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into 23 this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to 24 induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an 25 attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with 26 27 regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated 28 29 Final Order below. 30 111 31 STIPULATION OF FACTS 1. Jonathan Robert Luebke has been licensed by the Commission since October 15, 2008. 32 Luebke currently holds an Initial I Teaching License, with an endorsement in Multiple 33 Subjects (MIDLVL) and Social Studies (HS, ML); issued June 1, 2011, and valid through 34

35 36 On March 2, 2011, the Commission received Luebke's application for reinstatement of his expired Initial I Teaching License. According to Commission records, Luebke's Initial I Teaching License had expired on April 15, 2010. The Commission learned from Luebke's reinstatement application and the Arthur Academy's submitted Professional Educational Experience Report (PEER) form that Luebke had been teaching third grade, Multiple Subjects Self Contained, at the Arthur Academy Charter School and had been so employed since 2008.

- 3. The Commission's investigation determined that Luebke worked as a teacher, without either a valid license or registration from April 15, 2010, when his Initial Teaching License expired, until the Arthur Academy administration removed him from the classroom on or about May 25, 2011, when the administration realized Luebke's license had expired. As a result, Luebke taught without a valid license for a period of approximately thirteen (13) months.
- 4. Luebke has acknowledged his error in allowing his license to lapse and TSPC acknowledges that Luebke has worked with Commission staff to reach a reasonable resolution of this matter with the least burden possible for both parties.

## CONCLUSION OF LAW

Jonathan Robert Luebke taught at the Arthur Academy Charter School without a Charter School Registry or valid teaching license, from April 15, 2010, until May 25, 2011. This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175 (1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (*Knowingly working without a license*), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(2)(a) (*Apply for, accept*,

1	offer, or assign a position of responsibility only on the basis of professional		
2	qualifications, and will adhere to the conditions of a contract or the terms of the		
3	appointment).		
4	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon		
5	ORS 342.175.

8	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and		
9	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Jonathan Rober		
10	Luebke's Initial I Teaching License.
