


STIPULATION OF FACTS

1. The Commission has licensed Rotting since November 24, 2009. Rotting's current Charter School Registry, with an endorsement in Integrated Science, issued on November 24, 2009, is valid until November 24, 2012. During all relevant times, Rotting was employed by the Ace Academy.
2. On August 11, 2008, the Commission received Rotting's first application for Charter School Registration. Rotting believed that the fingerprints she had submitted to Portland Public Schools in order to teach summer school were on file with the Commission and therefore did not submit additional fingerprints with her August 2008 application. The Commission informed Rotting that her application was incomplete due to lack of fingerprints.
3. On April 27, 2010, Rotting wrote a letter to the Commission indicating that she did receive the notification that her application was incomplete. Rotting further indicated that she sent the requested materials sometime in January of 2009. The office assistant at ACE Academy confirmed that she sent the materials to the Commission in January, 2009. The Commission has no record of receiving the requested materials during the 2008-2009 school year.
4. In September of 2009 the Commission informed Rotting and Ace Academy that Rotting was not in compliance with licensure rules. On November 10, 2009, TSPC received a letter from Michael Taylor, Director of Ace Academy, regarding Rotting's failure to hold proper licensure.
5. On November 12, 2009, the Commission received the new C-1 application with complete fingerprints.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1 Marjan Antoinette Rotting served without a license or charter school registry at
2 Ace Academy beginning at the start of the 2008/2009 school year until the issuance her
3 license on November 24, 2009. This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in
4 violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-
5 020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (*Knowingly*
6 *working without a license*).

7 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
8 ORS 342.175, and OAR 584-050-000030(1) (*TSPC may deny a license if a person has*
9 *served in violation of licensure assignment. Such denial shall extend either for one year*
10 *from the date of application for licensure or for a period equal to the time served*
11 *without licensure, whichever is less. The Executive Director may issue a notice of intent*
12 *to deny the license and of opportunity for a hearing to the educator*).

13 **ORDER**

14 Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby orders as follows:

15 Marjan Antoinette Rotting's Charter School Registry is hereby suspended for 30
16 days.
