The above conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342-175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(a) (*Revocation, suspension or denial of a license by another state for reasons and through procedures that are the same as, or substantially equivalent to, those permitting similar action in Oregon), and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(b)(<i>Fraud or misrepresentation*).
