



1 Earnest William Evans enters into this Stipulation of Facts with knowledge that the  
2 Teacher Standards and Practices Commission will adopt and Order of Public  
3 Reprimand and Probation for two years. This Stipulation is contingent upon approval  
4 and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this  
5 Order, neither Mr. Evans nor the Commission are bound by these stipulations and Mr.  
6 Evans retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.

22 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

23  
24 Under ORS 342.175 the Commission may find a violation of Standards for Competent  
25 and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educators to constitute Gross Neglect of Duty.  
26

27 ORDER

28  
29 The Commission issues a Public Reprimand to Earnest William Evans for violation of  
30 Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educators and this  
31 Order constitutes the Public Reprimand. Additionally, the Commission places Evans  
32 on Probation for a period of two years from the date of this Order. The probationary  
33 status is subject to the following conditions:

- 35 1) Earnest William Evans shall conduct himself as a law-abiding citizen.

37 2) Evans shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance  
38 for Oregon Educators under OAR 584, Division 020.
