2 3. On November 8, 2006, Commission investigators contacted Ms. Cooper via regular
3 mail and certified mail to arrange a time for an interview regarding the conduct above. Ms.
4 Cooper did not respond to letters and has not submitted to an investigative interview.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

7 Cooper's conviction of five counts of Aggravated Theft, a class B felony, violates OAR
8 584-020-0040(5)(c), OAR 584-020-0040(3)(a), OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as in incorporates 584-
9 020-0035(3)(a), and OAR 584-0040(4)(n). Cooper's failure to respond to the Commission
10 investigation is in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(3)(c) and 584-020-040(4)(p).

11 **FINAL ORDER**

12 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of facts and
13 conclusions of law, and based thereon, hereby revokes the Standard Teaching License issued
14 to Cheryl Ann Cooper.
