7	Practices Commission (Commission), Robert Edwin Sullivan Jr.
8	(Sullivan), Sullivan has agreed to surrender his Oregon teaching
9	license pursuant to OAR 584-50-027. In surrendering his license,
10	Sullivan understands that he is waiving all rights to a hearing
11	under ORS 342.177 and that the Commission will accept his
12	surrender of license and impose a revocation of the license.
13	STIPULATION, WAIVER AND FINDINGS OF FACT
14	The Commission has received information indicating that
15	Sullivan engaged in inappropriate conduct with respect to a
16	student. Sullivan denies that he engaged in any inappropriate or
17	unethical conduct; however, in order to avoid potential
18	embarrassment to himself or others, he chooses not to contest the
19	allegations and to stipulate to the terms listed below. Sullivar
20	stipulates that there is substantial evidence in the files and
21	records of the Commission for the Commission to make the findings
22	set forth below. The Commission makes the following Findings of
23	Fact:
24	1. Sullivan holds a standard Oregon Teaching License with
25	endorsements in physical education and health.
26	

2. In February 1998, Sullivan had inappropriate contact 1 2 with a student of the Ontario High School. 3 In entering this stipulation, Sullivan understands that the 4 Commission will revoke his teaching license. Sullivan further agrees: (1) to waive his right to a hearing; (2) to waive 5 permanently his right under ORS 342.175(3) to apply for 6 reinstatement of his Oregon Teaching License; (3) to waive 7 permanently his right to apply for an Oregon Teaching License; 8 9 and (4) never to apply for a license to teach in preschool through grade 12 in any other state. Prior to entering into this 10 agreement, Sullivan has consulted legal counsel, and he fully 11 12 understands that he is permanently relinquishing his right to 13 obtain a license to teach. Based on the above findings, Sullivan agrees to surrender 14 15 his Oregon Teaching License and to allow the teaching license to 16 be revoked. 17 18 Robert Edwin Sullivan Date 19 20 21 22 Date David V.
