| 28                               | 1. Mr. Haevers has been licensed by the Commission since July 1, 1974. Mr. Haevers  |
| 29                               | currently holds a Basic Teaching License issued November 8, 2004, valid until November 5,   |
| 30                               | 2007, with Endorsements in Basic Elementary, Basic ESOL, and Basic Reading.   |

| 4   | 3. On July 1, 2005, Mark Joseph Haevers pled guilty and was convicted of Sex Abuse              |
