Mr. Armes requested a hearing 11 through his attorney, Sean Lyell, on December 10, 1997. 12 The Commission and Mr. Armes have now reviewed the matters 13 alleged and have agreed that their respective interests, together 14 15 with the public interest are best served by a surrender of Mr. Armes's teaching license and a stipulation to certain facts. 16 entering this stipulation, Mr. Armes waives his right to a 17 hearing and understands that the Commission will accept the 18 surrender of his license and issue an order revoking the license. 19 STIPULATED FACTS 20 Mr. Armes agrees and stipulates to the following findings of 21 fact by the Commission: 22 Mr. Armes holds a standard teaching license with a 23 1. subject endorsement in music. 24 Mr. Armes was employed as a teacher with the Beaverton 25 2.

11	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER
12	Based on the foregoing, the Commission finds that Mr.
13	Armes's conduct consisted of gross neglect of duty in violation
14	of OAR 584-20-0040(4)(f). Sexual contact with a student almost
15	always serves as a basis for revocation of a teacher's license.
16	Although the misconduct in this case, occurred several years ago,
17	the Commission concludes that the conduct was sufficiently
18	serious to justify revocation.
19	The Commission accepts the surrender of the teaching license
20	of Romey Roy Armes and orders that Mr. Armes's Oregon Teaching
21	License shall be revoked on the effective date of this order.
