9	Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Gary Wayne Rombach, in which the Commission
10	proposed to deny renewal of a license under ORS 342.135 and its administrative rules
11	implementing that legal authority OAR 584-050-0007. The Notice was sent via U.S. First
12.	Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt #7001 0320 0005 0740 4775 to the address Mr.
13	Rombach provided to the Commission. The certified mail receipt was signed by C. Rombach
14	and returned to the Commission on March 26, 2003. Gary Rombach did not request a
15	hearing.
6	The Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, signed by Victoria Chamberlain, Executive
17	Director, stated:
18 19 20 21 22 23	If a request for hearing is not received within this 21-day period, your right to hearing shall be considered waived unless your failure to request a hearing was beyond your reasonable control. If you do not request a hearing or if you fail to appear at a hearing, the Commission will uphold the denial of your application for an Oregon teaching license.
24	Based on the foregoing, the Commission finds Gary Wayne Rombach in default and
25	such default is hereby entered. Based on the records and files of the Commission, the
26	Commission enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order.
27	FINDINGS OF FACT
28	1. Mr. Rombach held a Basic Teaching License with an endorsement in Basic
29	Advanced Mathematics valid through February 12, 2003. At Mr. Rombach's request, this
30	license was renewed through grade 9 only.

1	2. On or about March 14, 2003, 15PC received an Application for Educator License
2	Form C-1 signed by Gary M. Rombach along with additional documentation to apply for renewal
3	of his Basic Teaching License. Rombach did not satisfy the necessary experience requirements
4	for a Basic Teaching License which requires that during the three-year period immediately
5	preceding application, he must have verified completion of properly assigned experience valid
6	through grade 9 of an elementary, middle, or junior high school.
7	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
8	Mr. Rombach' application for renewal of his Basic Teaching License is denied as he has
9	not satisfied the necessary experience requirements for renewal pursuant to OAR 584-048-0025
10	ORDER
11	The Commission denies renewal of a Basic Teaching License to Gary Wayne Rombach.
