ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Marie-Catherine Letendre violated Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educators by claiming to have a Masters of Arts degree from Portland State University and by attempting to cover that assertion with a counterfeit diploma.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Under ORS 342.175 and OAR 584, Division 020 false statements and forged official documents are grounds for a finding of gross neglect of duty.

ORDER

The Commission revokes the Oregon Teaching License of Marie-Catherine Letendre for falsification of documents related to her employment as an educator.


